The Middle School and High School Interim Reports are published in the student portal based on specific dates determined by the administration. All Lexington High School students will receive an email message in their First Class email account that the report (Report Card or Progress Report) is available in the student portal. Because Middle School students do not yet have email accounts associated with their Aspen accounts, they will not be notified by email, but their parents will. There will also be an announcement in the Student Portal banner informing them that the published reports are available in the student portals for viewing.

To view the reports:


